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Climatic tendencies! Is our earth getting warmer or colder? There is some evidence from relatively late instrumental records that it is getting warmer. It has been estimated that if all the polar ice were to melt the ocean level would be raised about 150 feet. This would put many a populous and wealthy city out of business, to say nothing of rich farm land rendered worthless. The change from one ice age to another is not a steady one. There were, and probably always will be, smaller variations of cold and warmth superimposed upon the larger ones. So we may be only on the warming side of a small change. At any rate, if we are to get warm enough to melt the ice sheets, it will take about 15,000 years; so why worry?
