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Temperature and snowfall! It is generally thought that winters with much snowfall are milder than those with little, and this is a fact. The largest snowfalls generally occur when the temperature is just slightly below the freezing point. The coldest regions of the world do not have heavy snowfalls. Verkhoyansk, Siberia, is an example; it has a winter average of 52.5 degrees below zero with a winter precipitation of only one-half inch. As a rule, we may say that cold seasons as well as cold regions are characterized by little snowfall.
