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Assorted winds! If one were to sort the winds one would probably arrange them according to their speeds as did Admiral Beaufort back in the old square-rigged man-of-war days. His scale ranged from 0 to 12, or from calm to hurricane. But the weatherman sorts them according to causes, therefore he gives us: (1) winds due to local heating, as sea breezes; (2) due to local cooling, as a land breeze; (3) due to both local heating and cooling, as a thunderstorm wind; (4) wind due to widespread heating and cooling, as trade winds and the winds accompanying our common storms (cyclones); and (5) wind due to other winds, as eddies and tornadoes.
