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Gardens in May! Winter has been steadily retreating farther and farther north but there are still chances for frost or even a freeze in the northern tier of states and in Canada. Work in the home gardens may, however, be thought of. In the North sow tender vegetables such as cucumbers, melons, squashes, lima beans, and tomatoes in the open. Transplant celery. About every ten days plant corn; also broccoli, Brussels sprouts, leeks, eggplant and pepper plants. Tomatoes may be safely set out at the end of the month in the extreme North and earlier farther south.
