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Spring weather! This is the time of the year when the weather is changing from the winter to the spring type. Indeed, in the South the spring type has already merged into summer, while in the North and in southern Canada the spring type is dominant. The spring type is distinguished by an occasional cyclone (or general storm) which might be very severe, accompanied by chilly, northeasterly winds, rain or even snow in the extreme northern tier of states or in southern Canada. Such a storm may have been preceded by a condition approaching a warm wave, the former a suggestion of the past winter and the latter a pledge of the coming summer.
