Plants and high temperature! While plants may endure a spell of very high temperature they will not grow when it is too hot. Plants are not active with temperatures over 90 degrees. What temperatures plants can endure depends upon their kind, condition and season. The dry seeds of plants, however, may survive temperatures as high as 212 degrees, but most plants live in temperatures below 105 degrees. While plants may survive a wide range of temperature, they are active only within a very narrow range.
