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Ocean travel! The vacationist who plans to sail next month (June) will have selected on the whole the best month of the year. In the North Atlantic moderate gales occur on the average only about one day or so in June. In the South Atlantic, while June is the beginning of the hurricane season, these storms are comparatively rare and of moderate strength. Fog is most frequent during June but is practically absent east of the 40th meridian and south of the 40th parallel. Likewise in the Pacific fogs are a source of discomfort but generally only in the northern latitudes. In the Pacific temperatures will vary from 45 to 60 degrees north of the 40th parallel. -----
