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Sea breeze! To get the best effect of these grateful breezes one must select his coast. They are most pronounced if the sea coast has hills or mountains for a background. Sea breezes are shallow, extending upward about 1000 feet. They depend upon a sharp change of temperature of the air from the surface upward. This is most pronounced after the heat from the sun has been acting for some hours, some time after midday when the soil is warmest, which in turn heats the overlying layer of air. In Jamaica at Port Royal, with the Blue Mountains for a background, the sea breeze is famous, said to be the strongest in the world.
