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Sailing the ocean blue! The coming July like the present month of June will be favorable for crossing the Atlantic, that is, especially for those who like smooth seas. While the season for tropical hurricanes has commenced, it has not advanced far. These storms, however, when they do occur, and have moved in an altered form into northern waters, are mostly responsible for such gales as may occur which are seldom very heavy. Fogs are about as frequent as in June over the Grand Banks, and common from Newfoundland to the Virginia Capes, and somewhat frequent over the western half of the main Atlantic routes to Europe.
