July gardens! This is the season when the cyclonic control of the weather is weakest, because the cyclonic storm belt has moved northward, and now the sun-control is strongest resulting in hot weather and thunderstorms. In the North make a last planting of corn. Keep on sowing radishes, early beets, kohlrabi, turnips and bush beans. Potatoes should be sprayed or dusted, and melons, tomatoes, squashes and beans protected from mildew and rust.
