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Town and country! Everyone notices the difference between the "feel" of the air in town and in the country. This is partly real and partly psychological. The real difference is in temperature, sunshine, and wind. The artificial heating and the warm pavements conduce to higher temperatures in the cities than in the adjacent country both in summer and winter, and also one feels in towns the radiation from the sides of buildings and pavement which is different from that from vegetation. Then there is less ventilation in the city, the buildings diminishing the winds. The smoke of cities gives rise to fogs, and in addition diminishes the intensity of the sunshine.

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
