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Climate of Lhasa! This is especially interesting as the home of the Grand Lama on the Tibetan Plateau. It is rather mild for its elevation of over 11,000 feet. There the peaches bloom in early April, indicating an early season. June is the warmest month, due to the fact that the latter part of the summer is cloudy; it has an average of 63 degrees with a highest of 83. January is the coldest month, averaging 32 degrees with a lowest of 7. As Lhasa is very high, the air is pure and thin, sunshine is intense and evaporation is rapid. The yearly rainfall is 63 inches, most of which falls between May and September. Irrigation is used extensively.
