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Dew! This phenomenon of early morning, especially common at this time of the year, may be forecast the same as any other weather condition, since scientists know how it is formed and the conditions favorable and unfavorable for its formation. Favorable conditions for the formation of dew are: (1) moist air, because obviously there must be some moisture present to be deposited; (2) clear skies, because then radiation is best and objects cool off quickly; and (3) no wind, because a wind mixes the air and brings new air next to the cooling objects, which delays their cooling. Dew in some places is an important agricultural factor.
