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Uncommon rainbows! To see a rainbow carpeting the ground has been the experience of a few. The light from the sun shines on drops of water which are clinging to cobwebs covering the ground, thus creating a perfect rainbow. Watch for them on the fairway. The same phenomenon has been observed on a lake, the surface of which was covered with water drops probably deposited by fog on an oily surface. In general, rainbows formed on the ground or on a sheet of water are called "horizontal rainbows" distinguished from the regular rainbows which are vertical, formed on falling drops of rain.
