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Weather and astronomy! Some believe that meteorology (the study of the weather) and astronomy are alike. Astronomers also study the atmospheres of other planets, but they are not particularly interested in the circulation of the atmosphere and the generation of storms. They do not study forecasting the weather, but forecasts of the weather, as well as the facts of climatology, are useful to them.

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
