Another and very important effect is to lower the temperature an amount depending upon the amount of dust in the atmospheres of both the sun and the earth. The amount of dust in the sun's atmosphere is dependent upon the number of sunspots, the more spots the more dust. The amount in the earth's atmosphere depends upon the number of artificial and natural fires, volcanic activity, shooting stars, and wind action upon ocean spray and the surface of the earth. The amount of dust blown up by the wind depends upon the condition of the surface as affected by the amount and frequency of rains. ---
