Weather service of the future! If the predictions of all weathermen regarding this question were fulfilled, we would have in 25 or 50 years a weather service as exact as the present time service. Instruments will have been invented to indicate the weather of all parts of the atmosphere over sea and land and the data transmitted at once to all forecasting agencies. Forecasts would then be made available to all activities for a day, week, month or year in advance through press, radio and telephone. One may in that future time take up his telephone, touch the proper button, and the required forecast will immediately be recited by robot information clerks.
