Unexpected climate! If when the Romans invaded England they had continued north along the west coast of Europe they would very unexpectedly have found a place, Lafoten Isles, off the northwest coast of Norway, 1200 miles north of London where the winter climate is about the same as that of Greece. The Lafoten Isles are on the 68th parallel, within the Arctic Circle and about 2100 miles farther north than Greece. There is no other place in the world where the temperature departs so much from the average of the latitude. Lafoten's January mean temperature is 40 degrees higher than what Caesar might have reasonably expected.
