February snow! On the first of this month snow covered the entire United States and Canada except the Southern States and along the Pacific coast. In the United States it was deepest in the Great Lakes region, particularly in Upper Michigan. For the United States as a whole January is the snowiest month; but as a rule more snow falls in February in the eastern half, while in the western half January has the most. For a yearly average Colorado is the snowiest state; California has large amounts also but its average is undeterminable, Florida has the least; in that state it is, indeed, very rare.
