Spring gardens! Spring weather is now on the way northward, and even upward on mountain slopes, and garden work in many places may soon begin. In the North, tomato, eggplant, cauliflower, cabbage and pepper seeds may be sown in hotbeds, or lacking these, in boxes in the house. Radishes and lettuce planted in hotbeds may mature there. Asparagus beds may be fertilized. When ground is ready to work, the gardener may sow seeds of spinach, radishes, early peas, beets, onion sets and lettuce. He may dig, before they begin to grow, parsnips and salsify left in the ground over the winter.
