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Winter in spring! From approximately March 22 to 27 a good part of eastern United States and Canada experienced winter weather. Low temperatures prevailed and snow fell in many places especially in Canada. It certainly was not average weather for the season; but it was not more abnormal than a thaw in January. The explanation is the usual one: a high pressure condition accompanied by a mass of polar air. Average or seasonal weather may be experienced day after day, often a season will average normal on the whole but be interspersed with spells of abnormally cold and warm weather which may be expected anytime especially in northeastern United States and southeast Canada.

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
