Air made to order! To make a room comfortable and pleasant seems to be the common thought in regard to air conditioning; and of course it does that. This use is very important, however, in schools that conduct summer courses as all business colleges and many universities do. Air conditioning class rooms results in higher study efficiency. Air-conditioning also has important industrial uses. Workrooms where materials are used requiring a certain amount of moisture are air conditioned to bring this about. It has been found in blast furnace operations that lowering the moisture reduces the amount of coke burned for each ton of iron produced.
