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Protection from lightning! Where a thunderstorm is occurring there is no particular spot entirely free from danger of being hit by lightning. The safest place is one which, if hit, least harm will result. This is one entirely surrounded by metal, either solid or a network (as a steel frame building), or in an underground chamber. The next best is a building protected by lightning rods, which is better than being in the open or under trees. In an ordinary dwelling, the best place is in the middle of an inner room, provided one does not stand or sit under a lighting fixture. The more dangerous places in a hour are near masses of metal, such as stoves, radiators, downspouts and screen doors.
