Weather prophecy! An individual would prosper enormously if he could foretell the weather one year in advance. And if such information were broadcast the farmers would be benefited and other activities would gain in efficiency. But at present rather shorter forecasts, for only 5 to 10 days, are attempted. Even this work is proceeding slowly. It takes a long time to unlock the secrets of nature. The best forecasts are those for 24 to 48 hours issued by various weather organizations. At many places these forecasts are available to the public by simply calling the right number on the telephone.
