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Sea breezes! These cool, moist breezes off the ocean are the comfort and delight of those who dwell on or near the coast. They are caused by the unequal heating of the ocean and land. During the day the land becomes the warmer, and the air over it rises and the cool, heavier air from the sea moves in. These breezes are most evident on the warmer coasts where the contrast between ocean and land heating is greatest. The sea breeze diminishes in intensity toward the north. The reverse breeze, called the land breeze, occurs at night, the air from the cooler land moves out to sea.
