Singapore and Batavia! These much discussed places have abundant rains every month. They both lie close to the equator, and the seasonal changes in temperature are very small. The annual temperature range (that is, from the average of the coolest to the warmest month) is only about 3 degrees at Singapore and 2 at Batavia. Singapore has 173 rainy days, with an average of 93 inches of rain a year, and Batavia has 73 inches of rain. While the temperature never rises above 94 degrees, the dampness causes the heat to be much more oppressive than higher temperatures in drier regions. Hurricanes may occur any month, but the season of their greatest frequency is from July to October.
