Snow cover! Some amazing stories are told of people lying out in the open, covered with snow, and surviving. Several instances are recorded where people were found alive after being buried under snow several days; in one instance for eight days. It seems that one important condition is that there be a small hole opening to the free air for breathing. While these people were numb from cold and inaction, they were not frozen stiff and lived to tell the tale. Snow cover is advantageous for fall-sown grain. The protection is due to the low heat conductivity of snow. Freshly fallen snow is best as it contains many air pockets.
