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Anticyclonic weather! Anticyclonic weather in winter is distinguished by clear, dry and cold bracing air with generally no or very light winds. This condition is due to a very large mass of air coming down from the Arctic regions generally following one of the winter's storms with which they are connected. This cold anticyclonic air generally warms up somewhat because of descending air and by contact with a warmer earth. The coldest weather of winter occurs when we are visited by these cold anticyclones, but their influence is generally for a short time only as they move to the east or lose their energy.
