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Storm! What is a "storm"? Admiral Beaufort, in his specifications of wind forces, defines a "storm wind" as a whole gale and over 75 miles an hour. But a storm in general is a violent disturbance of the atmosphere, accompanied by high winds, copious rain, heavy snows, thunder and lightning, or any combination of them. Storms travel. Widespread ones are called cyclones and hurricanes. More localized ones are tornadoes and thunder-storms. The storminess of a region is measured by the frequency of these disturbances.
