Beginning of spring! If spring begins with the average date of blossoming of common spring-flowering plants, then the date varies from one locality to another, and it is therefore not easy to assign a definite date. In Great Britain the spring months are February, March and April; in the United States and in Canada, March, April and May are considered the spring months. Astronomers, however regard spring as beginning with the vernal equinox, this year March 20, and ending with the summer solstice about June 21.
